Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ's)

1. What are the requirements for our Swim School to join the Network?

- a. The only requirement to join the new AUSTSWIM Swim School Network is for your school to employ AUSTSWIM teachers. The number of teachers you employ is not a factor.

2. When does the discount to courses apply?

- a. Once you have paid for your registration, you will be provided with information on how to access your enrolment, renewal and licence transfer discounts.

3. When will I receive my digital badge and window decals?

- a. After we have confirmed the payment of your registration, our Swim School Network team will send you your digital decal, confirm your postal address and send out your window decals.

4. When will I have to pay?

- a. Payment is required upon the processing of your application.

SMART AND SKILLED FUNDING IN NSW

Diversify your career opportunities or gain employment by joining Australia's best swimming teachers by becoming an AUSTSWIM Licensed Teacher of Swimming and Water Safety.

AUSTSWIM is inviting expressions of interest (EOI) to complete the AUSTSWIM Teacher of Swimming and Water Safety course. This training is fully subsidised by the NSW Government as part of the Smart and Skilled program.

Eligibility for Candidates

- Lives or works in NSW (Determined by postcode of the usual place of residence or place of work); and
- Are unemployed, and are seeking skills to obtain employment or work towards a higher level of education i.e. Certificate III; or
- Are an:
 - An Australian citizen; or
 - A permanent Australian resident; or
 - A New Zealand citizen; or
 - A humanitarian visa holder or a partner visa holder whose sponsor is a humanitarian visa holder (determine by visa condition check - VEVO); and
- Are 16* years or over; and
- Is no longer in secondary education (except for registered home school students).
- Has a valid Unique Student Identifier (USI)

*Age has been amended to reflect the minimum age requirement for an AUSTSWIM Licence.

Important information you need to know before submitting your expression of interest

- Submitting an EOI does not automatically guarantee your spot on a course. The final selection in a fully subsidised AUSTSWIM Teacher of Swimming and Water Safety Course depends on your eligibility, government funding allocations and available space on a course.
- The AUSTSWIM Course must be completed within 3 months of attending the face-to-face workshop.
- At the face-to-face workshop, candidates will be required to swim 10 metres and tow a person in water to safety over 10 metres.

2025 Awards of Excellence

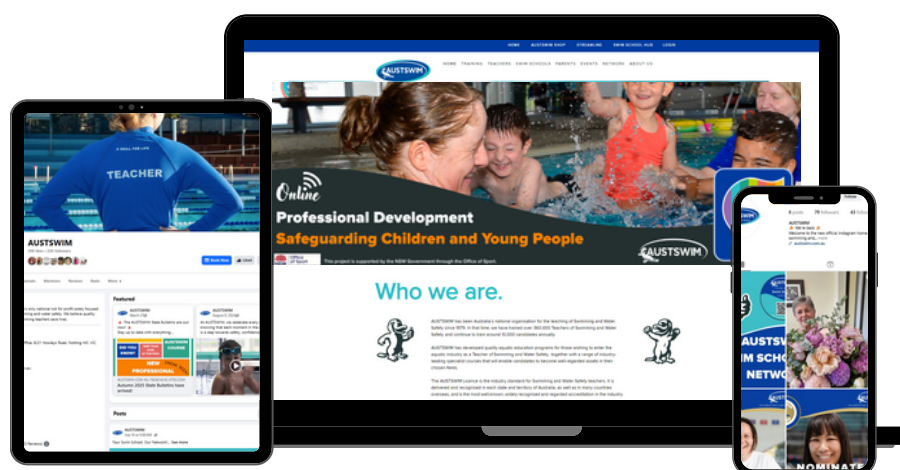


AUSTSWIM launched its 2025 Awards of Excellence on the 12 May 2025!
